

## OATS Hall of Fame Criteria

Members of OATS shall be eligible for nomination and election to the OATS Hall of Fame after accrual of 10 years of membership and by achieving a score of 35\* or greater on the following scale:

	Officer of OATS	1 per term, 4 max
	Officer of NWATA, NATA, or other regional/national organization of special interest to the profession of athletic training (i.e.- CATS, PBATS, NWAACC, etc)	1 per instance*, 2 max
	OATS Committee membership (separate from office)	1 per instance, 4 max
	Service on an NWATA, NATA, or NATABOC committee, board, or task force	1 per instance*, 2 max
	Service on the Board of Athletic Trainers for the State of Oregon	1 per term, 2 max
	Model/Examiner for NATABOC exam in Oregon	1 per exam, 4 max
	Consistent (>50%) attendance at OATS meetings/symposia	2
	<b>Professional Accomplishment</b>	
	Speaker at OATS, NWATA, or NATA meeting/symposia	1 per instance*, 4 max
	OATS, NWATA or NATA award of service or distinction	1 per instance*, 4 max
	Recognition (related to athletic training performance) at place of employment, by citation, award, or institutional ceremony	1 per instance*, 4 max
	Professional activities (publication in peer-reviewed journal, authorship of book, consultation services, USOC volunteering, etc.)	1 per instance*, 4 max
	<b>Community Service and Accomplishment</b>	
	Speaker at community service organization, health care organization, local medical society, coaches association, or other group not affiliated with an athletic training organization	1 per instance*, 8 max
	Service to a community or charitable organization (i.e.- Red Cross, Rotary, Special Olympics, Church, etc.)	1 per instance*, 8 max

\*Points shall be awarded only for those instances of service and accomplishment that occurred during membership in OATS. Instances occurring before or after membership in OATS, while possibly significant in election, cannot be used to meet minimum qualifications.
